Dear Parents/ Carers,

As mentioned in the main newsletter, we are once again going on an Adventure Learning Day to Borwick Hall Outdoor Centre on Monday 27th September. All of the children from Y1 to Y6 will go. As usual, the day will be action-packed with the children taking part in a range of adventurous activities. We are aiming for the trip to be an opportunity for the children to challenge themselves and take risks, persevere, work as part of a team and, most importantly, have fun! We ask that you drop your children off and collect them again at the end of the day from Borwick Hall. Dropping off will be at 9am and collection at 5pm so we can maximise our time at the Centre. Please be prompt dropping off and collecting.

The children will be taking part in a range of activities. **All children** will need to wear the following clothing for the day:

All of the children will also need to bring a packed lunch, snacks and drinks.

Borwick Outdoor Centre, along with all Lancashire County Council Centres, charge £33 per pupil for the day's activities. We are going to heavily subsidise the trip by paying a significant amount of the cost from our Sports Funding money. The charge per pupil will therefore be £12 which is excellent value for a full day of adventurous activities including canoeing, rafting, climbing, etc.

The arrangements for dropping off and picking up are as follows:

Please pull into the car park opposite Borwick Hall where staff will be waiting for your children at 9am. School staff will then organise the safe crossing of the road to the Centre for all the children. Similarly, we will meet you in the entrance to the Centre opposite the car park at 5pm. Please wait in the entrance area and we will ensure your children are safely delivered to you.
