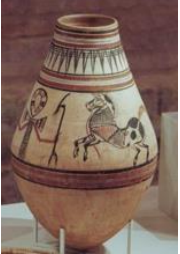


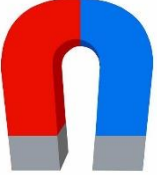




Sycamore Class Home Challenges - Long, Long Ago

Here are a range of challenges to try at home! You can try just one or as many as you like. Please make sure to bring in your excellent work!

<p><u>Create a piece of Egyptian pottery</u> Create a sculpture. Look at famous images on Google for inspiration.</p> 	<p><u>Keeping Fit</u> Keep a fitness diary for two weeks listing all of the exercise you have done to keep fit.</p> 	<p>Create fact files or PowerPoint presentations about different time periods Long, Long Ago. Possible periods of History: Stone Age, the Ancient Civilisations, the Romans, Vikings and Anglo Saxons.</p> 
<p> Explore where magnets are used in everyday life. Can you find any magnets in your house? Draw a diagram to demonstrate whether they attract or repel.</p>	<p>Investigate forces you use when moving around on your bike, scooter, skateboard or when playing sports. You could draw a diagram showing how you push, pull, start and stop.</p>	<p>Write a story with illustrations. Make the characters go on an exciting journey. Maybe they travel to Ancient Egypt or to the time of the dinosaurs!</p>
<p>Look at the food packaging in your kitchen cupboard at home. Find out where at least 10 foods come from and find the places on a map.</p> 	<p><u>Ancient Egyptians</u> Find out about the lives of Ancient Egyptian people, how are they different from what we experience today?</p>	<p><u>Internet Safety Poster</u> Create a poster that details how younger children can stay safe on the internet.</p>
